Sorin was born on May 7, 1985, to a family of accomplished musicians. Growing up surrounded by the sound of classical and contemporary music, he started studying the violin and clarinet at the age of seven. At thirteen, Sorin won the National Music Olympics and two years later was featured as a soloist with the Romanian Philharmonic Orchestra "*Mihail Jora*." In 2009, he graduated from the George Enescu University of Arts with a degree in classical clarinet.

During the university years, Sorin started to experiment with jazz. Beginning as an autodidact, his musical influences shifted to the work of Dizzy Gillespie, Keith Jarret, Miles Davis, Thelonious Monk, Bud Powell, Oscar Peterson, Chick Corea etc. He found the piano as the sublime instrument to reflect his innermost feelings as a composer and orchestrator and decided to perfect his technical virtuosity by pursuing a master's in music degree at the Romanian National University of Music, the Piano Jazz Section, from which he graduated Summa Cum Laude in 2011.

Sorin's style is a surprising fusion of jazz, Latin, pop, and classical music, which erupts into a colorful and fascinating repertoire. His talent gained him instant recognition on the international jazz scene. He proved to be a promising young musician from the beginning of his performing career, by winning the Grand Prize at the 2009 International Student Jazz Competition, in Targul Mures, Romania and the Grand Prize at the 2010 International Jazz Competition, in Sibiu, both while still a student.

Starting in 2011, he won top place at several renowned international jazz competitions. Some of them are: The Great American Piano Competition Jacksonville, Florida – Grand Prize (2015); International Jazz Competition, Getxo, Spain - Best Solo Performance, Best Band Performance, and Prize of the Public (2011); Montreux Jazz Piano Competition, Montreux, Switzerland - Finalist Prize (2015), International Jazz Competition, Monaco - Grand Prize

and Prize of the Public (2013); International Jazz Competition, Lille, France - Golden Jazz Trophy and Special Prize of the Jury and (2014). He was also a two-time winner of the "Best Jazz Musician of the Year" award in his home country and received the Citizen of Honor Distinction in 2018. In 2020, due to his rich track record, Sorin was honored to join the Yamaha Music company as a Yamaha Artist.

Sorin performed at numerous international venues, festivals, and jazz clubs either solo or with his trio/quartet. Notable festivals and clubs include Jacksonville Jazz Festival (Florida, United States), Washington Jazz Festival, New Orleans Jazz Festival & Jazz Conference, Blue Note (New York), Smalls Jazz Club (New York), Birdland Jazz Club (New York), Ronnie Scott's (London), Vortex Jazz Club (London), Music Village (Bruxelles), B-Flat Jazz Club (Berlin), Seoul Jazz Festival, King's Place Hall (London), Izmir Jazz Festival (Turkey), Nardis Jazz Club (Istanbul), Jefferson Theatre (Beaumont U.S.A), Roccella Jazz Festival (Italy), Montreux Jazz Festival, Getxo Jazz Festival (Spain), Sibiu Jazz Festival, Jazz Napocensis, Cluj Napoca, Bucharest Jazz Festival, Jazz Compass Festival, Perra Festival (Istanbul, Turkey), Jazz Hoeillart (Belgium), Enter Enea Music Festival (Poland) etc.

He had the chance to share the stage and collaborate with great artists such as: Jerry Bergonzi, Howard Levy, Woody Witt, Joris Teppe, Rick Margitza, Kenny Garett, Lee Ritenour, Branford Marsalis, Lee Konitz, Chick Corea, Joey Alexander, Roy Hargrove, Chris Potter, Chucho Valdes, Sonny Emory, Jeff Ballard, Dave Grusin, Ravi Coltrane, Leszek Mazdzer, and more.

In the summer of 2015, Sorin released his first album, entitled *Endurance*, a work centered on the power of love and family. The album was inspired by Sorin's younger sister who started battling cancer in 2011. It was from the pain, suffering, and turmoil that arose from those events,

that the song *Roxane* was born, a song whose melody masterfully encompasses all those emotions. With influences from the Latin, flamenco, and classical music styles combined with jazz, each song on *Endurance* reaches new harmonic and rhythmic depths that leave a lasting impression with the audience.

Sorin's latest album is entitled *The Land of Dreams*. Having had the opportunity to perform alongside numerous national and international artists, he wanted to create an album showcasing musicians coming from different generations, cultures, and schools of thought, but who are all unified by the common language of jazz. The project features artists from all over the world that Sorin collaborated with in recent years, with each of them bringing his unique style to the table: Gianni Gagliardi - sax (Spain), Gianluca Renzi - bass (New York), Iulian Nicolau - drums (Romania), Woody Witt - sax (USA), David Craig - bass (USA), Daniel Dufour – drums (USA), Riley Lonergan - sax (UK), Mikele Montolli - bass (UK), Andy Trim – drums (UK), Catalin Milea - sax (Romania), and Michele Acker - bass (Romania). With styles ranging from cool jazz to post-bop, Latin, flamenco, funk, and avant-garde, *The Land of Dreams* is the realm of all the musicians and music is its universal language.
